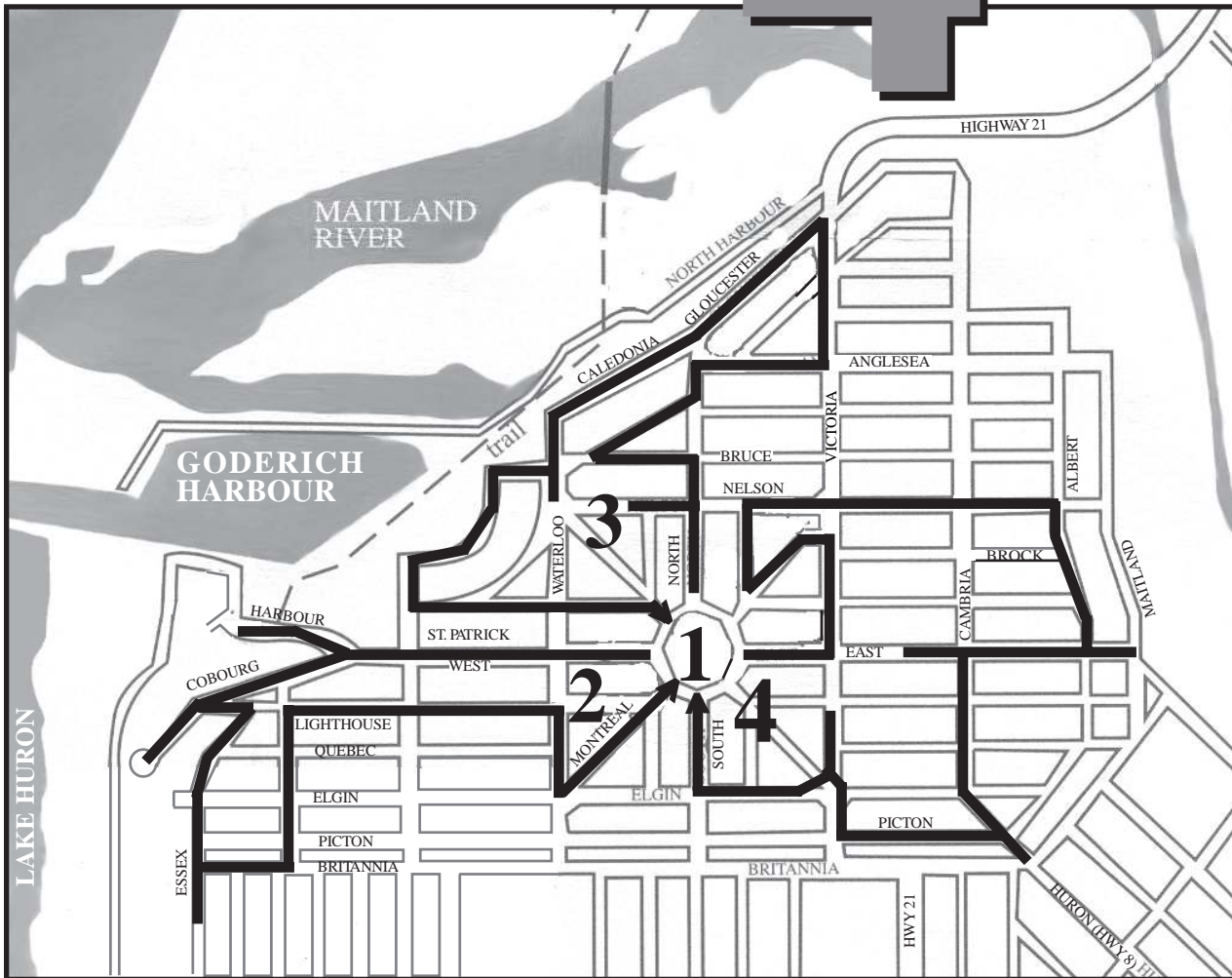

Heritage buildings in Goderich, designated under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, are identified by a bronze plaque on the front facade of the building.

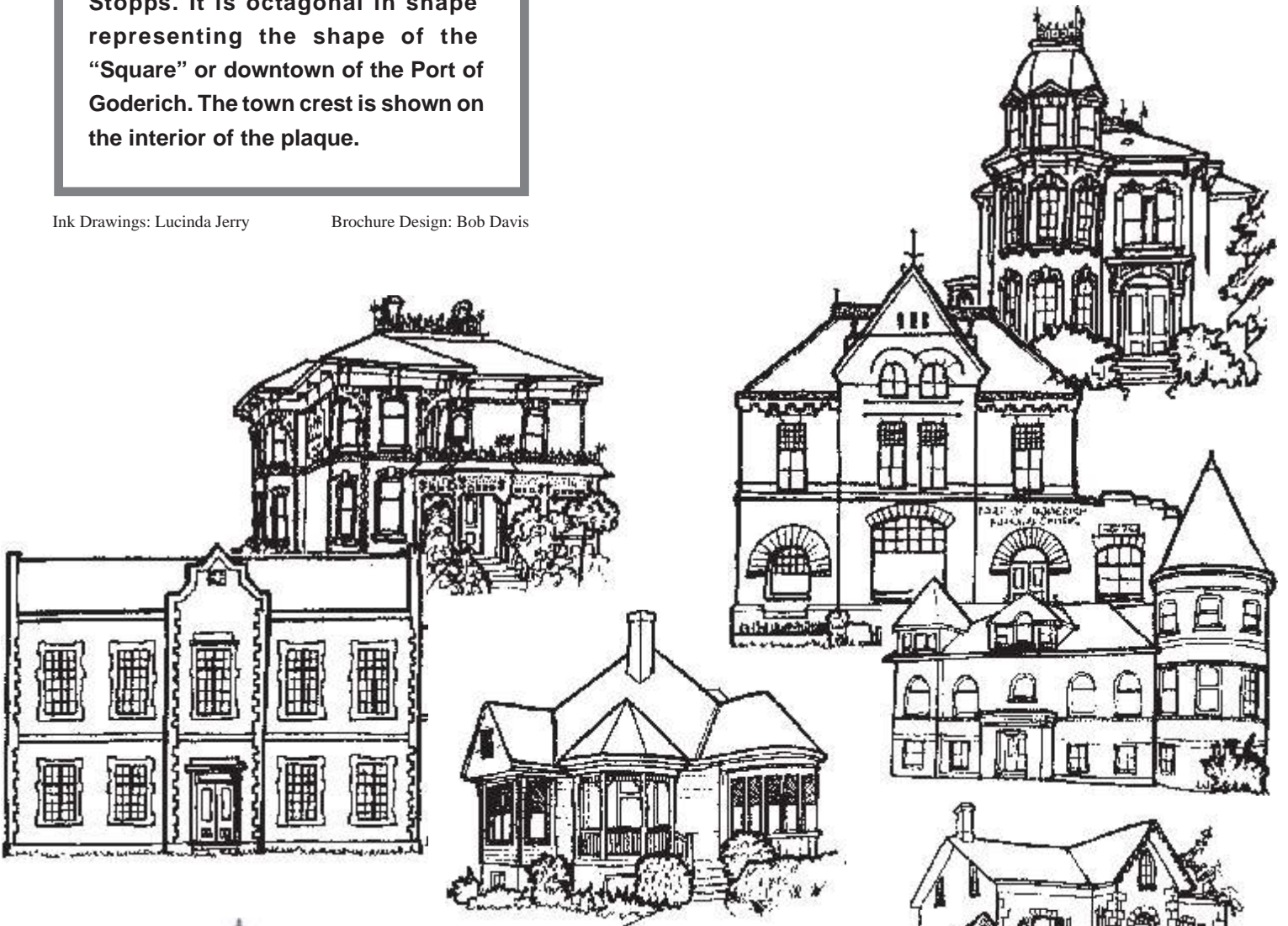

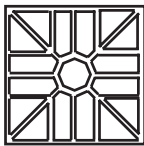
