



Requires Part-Time E.C.E. Teachers and/or Child Care/Program Assistants (Non-E.C.E.)

Childcare ECE Teachers will assist in planning and providing of a balanced child development program conducive to the emotional, physical, social and intellectual development of children at the Municipal Child Care Centre.

Child Care/Program Assistants will provide a care and education program for young children in a group setting under the direction of the Child Care Teacher.

The ideal candidate will possess the following qualifications, decision making and judgement skills:

- ❖ Minimum of two (2) year Childhood Education Diploma or equivalent approved by the provincial licensing process, such as R.E.C.E.
- ❖ Knowledge of the Occupational Health & Safety Act, the Child Care and Early Years Act, 2014, the Public Health Act and the ability to meet the specifications of these regulations and any others that apply to this work.
- ❖ First Aid/CPR with infant CPR.
- ❖ Set reasonable behaviour expectations consistent with the Centre's philosophy and policies
- ❖ Follow behaviour guidance policies established by the Centre.
- ❖ Participate with Centre peers to ensure the safety and well-being of the children while in the care of the Centre
- ❖ Good time management and program planning skills to provide a quality learning environment for all children
- ❖ Excellent communication skills to build relationships with children, parents and peers and to prepare reports and documents on the HiMama app
- ❖ Knowledge of Building on How Does Learning Happen document and the foundations for learning and healthy development
- ❖ Clean valid Vulnerable Sector Reference Check
