TAKE NOTICE that the Town of Goderich Committee of Adjustment will hold an electronic public hearing at the Town of Goderich Municipal Offices (57 West Street, Goderich) on December 7th, 2020 at 10:30 am to consider a proposed minor variance under Section 45 of the Planning Act (RSO 1990), as described below and shown on the attached map.

LOCATION OF PROPERTY: 200 Picton Street East, Goderich, being Plan 457 Part of Lot 334

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The purpose of this application is to seek relief from Zoning By-law 124-2013 of the Town of Goderich.

The applicant is proposing a basement staircase in the southwest side yard to provide improved access to the basement.

EXISTING ZONING BY-LAW PROVISIONS: The subject property is zoned Low Density Residential (R2) in the Town of Goderich Zoning By-law, which establishes a minimum interior sideyard setback of 1.5 metres where there is an attached garage.

PROPOSED MINOR VARIANCE: The application requests relief from the minimum interior sideyard setback, requesting a minimum setback of 0.6 metres.

If you are an owner of any land containing seven or more residential units you are requested to post this notice in a location that is visible to all of the residents.

FAILURE TO ATTEND - If you do not attend at the hearing, it may proceed in your absence and, except as otherwise provided in the Planning Act, you will not be entitled to any further notice in the proceedings.

NOTICE OF DECISION - If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Committee of Adjustment in respect of this application, you must submit a written request to the Committee of Adjustment. This will also entitle you to be advised of a possible Local Planning Appeal Tribunal hearing in the event the decision on this application is appealed.

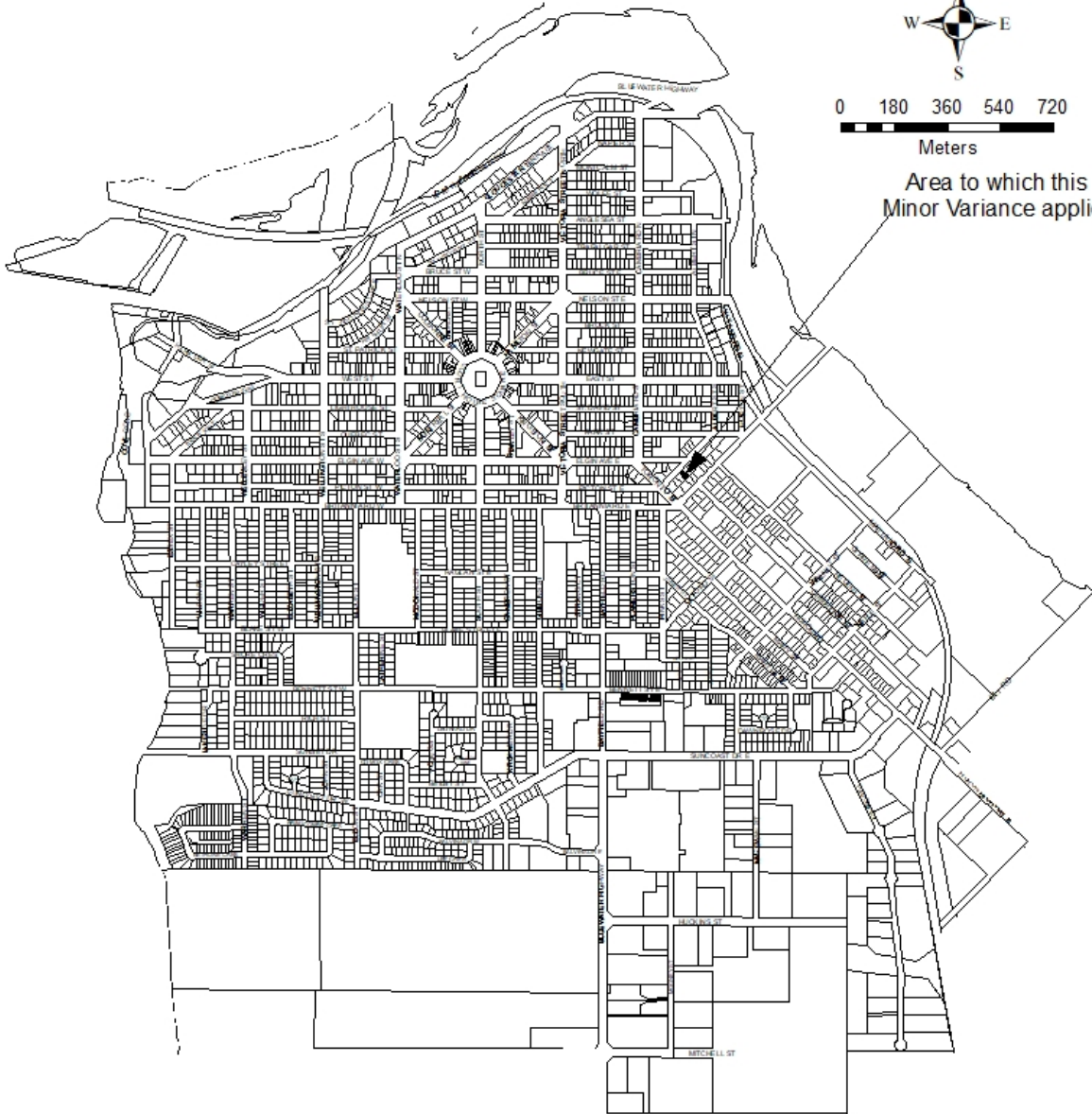
