The Full-Time Recreation Facilities Operator will perform the day-to-day operations and preventative maintenance of the recreational buildings and outdoor recreation locations which consists of the operations and maintenance associated with the Maitland Recreation Centre, Goderich Memorial Arena, Bannister Park, Columbus Park, Victoria Park, and related special events.

Under the direction of the Recreation Facilities Supervisor and/or the Community Services and Operations Manager, the successful applicant will perform the following duties and responsibilities:

- Daily opening and closing of buildings.
- Providing general maintenance to recreation facilities, and community outdoor recreation locations, including line painting and net installation
- Maintaining pool (water chemistry, filtration system, chlorination, general pool systems and equipment) to ensure it is in excellent sanitary and working conditions.
- Completing tasks for a variety of maintenance and equipment by documenting water quality tests and adding corrective chemicals in logs
- Assisting with minor repairs of facilities and equipment at Maitland Recreation Centre, Goderich Memorial Arena, and community recreation fields.
- Assisting with facility cleaning when required
- Conducting building checks, and exterior grounds/parking lot maintenance
- Removing snow and ice from all entrance and fire exits and shovels and applies ice management products as required on walkways.
- Reporting all accident/incidents/near misses
- Performing inspections, including fire safety equipment, etc.
- Related special events set up and tear downs at Maitland Recreation Centre, Goderich Memorial Arena, Bannister Park, Columbus Park, and Victoria Park
- Monitoring groups and individuals using facilities, identifies problems and takes the necessary steps for corrective action.
- Completing other related duties as assigned by Recreation Facilities Supervisor and/or designate.

- Valid Certified Pool Operator (CPO) or willingness to obtain.
- Valid Basic Refrigeration Certificate or willingness to obtain.
- Working at Heights Training or willingness to obtain

- Valid Class "G" driver's licence
- Clean Driver's Abstract
