



Requires a Parks/Cemetery Student Operator

The Town of Goderich is currently accepting applications for a Parks/Cemetery Student Operator. The Parks/Cemetery Student Operator will perform the day-to-day operations and maintenance duties for parks, trails, waterfront and cemetery, and deal with the public while following safety procedures. The Parks/Cemetery Student Operator position operates under a Collective Agreement.

The ideal candidate will possess the following qualifications:

- Self-motivated individual.
- High level of comfort in dealing with the public
- Ability to effectively work in a team environment
- Manual dexterity required to operate tools and equipment
- Ability to function effectively and safely in a variety of environmental conditions
- Ability to perform physical work (lifting (up to 50 lbs), sitting, walking, standing, bending, pushing, pulling, reaching, carrying, etc.)
- Clean Criminal Record Check
- Valid Ontario "G" Driver's Licence
- Clean Driver's Abstract
- Must be able to work from May to Labour Day
- Enrollment in a post-secondary program of a related field (i.e., Horticultural Technician, Landscape Design or Urban Arboriculture-Tree Care) or related experience is considered an asset

The hourly rate of pay is \$21.00 per hour (2024 Rate). Work occurs in an outdoor environment in all weather conditions with regular public contact. This position requires long periods of standing, sitting and walking. This position works 40 hours per week with core operating hours of 7 AM – 4 PM, Monday through Friday, but required to perform work on weekends on a rotational basis as part of the regular work week. As required, overtime and unusual hours to manage parks and cemetery operations and emergencies. The Town of Goderich offers voluntary enrolment in the OMERS Pension Plan and a productive team environment for personal growth and success.
