- Purchase on behalf of the Centre, supplies sufficient for preparing healthful and nutritious lunches and snacks for children, and lifting and unloading of food orders
- Preparation of menu items for children with allergies or dietary limitations
- Preparing kitchen area and maintaining in an organized and sanitary conditions pursuant to health standards as well as the cleanup of eating and kitchen areas following daily use
- Knowledge of the Occupational Health and Safety Act and the Public Health Act and ability to meet the specifications of these regulations and any others that apply to this work
- Ability to multi-task in a busy/high paced work environment and will be exposed to environmental noise
- Safe Food Handling Certification
- Valid Class G Ontario driver's license
- Valid First Aid/CPR-C AED certificates
- Clean and valid Vulnerable Sector background check
- Proof of COVID-19 immunization (fully vaccinated before date of commencement of employment)

The hourly rate of pay is \$18.96- \$22.58 (2021 Rates), working up to 8 hours per week with opportunity for additional hours when required.
