

## Lawn Watering

Properties with an even numbered address may water on an even calendar day while properties with an odd numbered address may water on an odd calendar day. Properties without an automatic watering system may water between the hours of 7 AM and 9 AM and between 7 PM and 9 PM, while properties with an automatic watering system may water between 2:30 AM and 6 AM on the applicable days.

## Municipal & School Board Election

The next Municipal and School Board Election will be held on Monday, October 26, 2026.

You are eligible to vote in the municipal and school board election in the Town of Goderich if, on October 26, 2026, you:

- Are a Canadian Citizen
- Are at least 18 years old
- Reside in Goderich, or are the owner or tenant of land in Goderich or the spouse of such owner or tenant
- Are not prohibited from voting

### Updating Your School Support

Property owners in Ontario must designate support for a school system, even if they do not have children or if their children do not currently attend school. 



# 5 Ways to Pay Your Taxes

1. Pre-Authorization Plan: Set up automatic withdrawals on the due dates or monthly on the 15th. Visit Town Hall or email [tdarnbrough@goderich.ca](mailto:tdarnbrough@goderich.ca) to sign up.
2. Bank/Credit Union: Pay in person, by phone, or online.
3. In Person: Pay with cash, cheque, or debit at Town Hall.
4. Mail: Mail your cheque and tax stub to 57 West St. Goderich, ON N7A 2K5.
5. Dropbox: Located at 57 West St. Goderich (Cheques Only).

Please Note: Payments must be received by the due date. A 1.25% penalty applies on the first day of default and monthly thereafter. Non-receipt of a tax notice does not exempt you from payment obligations, penalties, or interest.
