



Weekly Construction Update - Rebuilding Downtown Infrastructure Project

ALL BUSINESSES ARE OPEN: Pedestrian pathways allow patrons access to all businesses. Please see navigational maps posted on construction fencing when approaching closed roads.

Notice: Anticipate NO THROUGH ACCESS between Scotiabank and Elizabeth's Art Gallery between October 14-16. Unifor Local 16-0 is repairing their building foundation.

*Please note that this is not part of the Rebuilding Downtown Infrastructure Project.

Please follow Detour 4 when approaching downtown in a vehicle.

Summary:

- Current Phase: Phase 2 (West St. to South St.)
- Achievements: Curbs throughout Phase 2 are completed.
- This week: Concrete planters will be formed, and light poles are in the process of being installed.
Reminder: NO VEHICLE ENTRY/ EXIT to Courthouse Square via West St.

Information:

- Active construction Monday to Friday 7 AM to 6 PM
- Sidewalks are open in front of businesses and the inner Courthouse Square
- Driving around the Courthouse Square remains in one direction; ONLY turning right while entering and exiting.

1. Parking:

- Open: South St. around the Courthouse Square to West St.
- **Parking ONLY:** Colborne St. to West St. (Please reverse slowly and exit left onto Colborne St.)
- Closed: No parking from West St. to South St. on the Courthouse Square.

2. Accessibility:

- Businesses: **ALL OPEN** with regular operating hours. Sidewalks are accessible on the outer and inner side of the Courthouse Square.
- Pedestrian Access Routes: Inner Courthouse Square sidewalks can be accessed via South St., Kingston St., East St., Hamilton St., North St., and Colborne St.

3. Closures & Timeline:

- **Roads Closed:** Around the Courthouse Square from West St. to South St.
